The Chairperson stated that the Open Meetings Act is located on the north wall for review. Moved by Stava, seconded by Wilken to approve agenda minutes from December 17, 2024. Motion by Hans, seconded by Wilken to approve expenses RCV: Ayes: Stava, Benedict, Hans, Wilken. Nays: None. Carried.
